



4.2.1: Teaching Hospital, equipment, clinical teaching-learning and laboratory facilities are as stipulated by the respective Regulatory Bodies

The Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital has a hospital located inside its campus. This hospital is operated by the Education Welfare Trust. This hospital was founded in 2001. The hospital has a maximum capacity of 50 beds available for the admission of patients requiring indoor care.

The facility has an Outpatient Department (OPD), and a Pediatrics ward. The hospital is equipped with a well-equipped Intensive Care Unit (ICU) that includes patient monitors, inline oxygen delivery.

OT has the necessary capabilities to do significant surgical procedures, such as joint replacements. Provisions are included for labor and aseptic operating theaters. The wards consist of separate sections for males and females, as well as an isolation ward equipped with in-line oxygen delivery.

Clinical teaching and learning activities are conducted according to the clinical calendar for pre-final and final undergraduate student housemen. In addition, the doctors and surgeons who are on-call are assigned the responsibility of conducting clinical teaching and training for students. The institution has established joint Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with many hospitals located near the college campus.

All services are provided at affordable rates.

The hospital has rendered invaluable assistance by distributing medications to more than 3.3 million individuals throughout the Covid epidemic. Furthermore, our company serves as a hub for Hemophilia therapy and has provided medical care to a total of 230 individuals.

The hospital offers a range of facilities, including a physiotherapy and naturopathy section that provides services such as hydrotherapy, meditation, and yoga treatment.

The Central Council of Research in Homoeopathy is a unit.

The hospital comprises outpatient departments (OPDs) that are connected to case taking desks. The facility has Reception, Registration, and Dispensing counters staffed by highly qualified personnel. Well-ventilated waiting room equipped with comfortable chairs for both patients and their family members. The institution prides itself on possessing a collection of 1900 medicines, which span a wide range of potencies. The OPD offers students the opportunity to get diverse and detailed practical experience via case studies and interactions with professionals and instructors. The Outpatient Department (OPD) consists of specialty clinics and the five subjects specified in the Medical Services Regulations (MSR).
