Spending time with tree plantation activity reduces daily amount of stress.

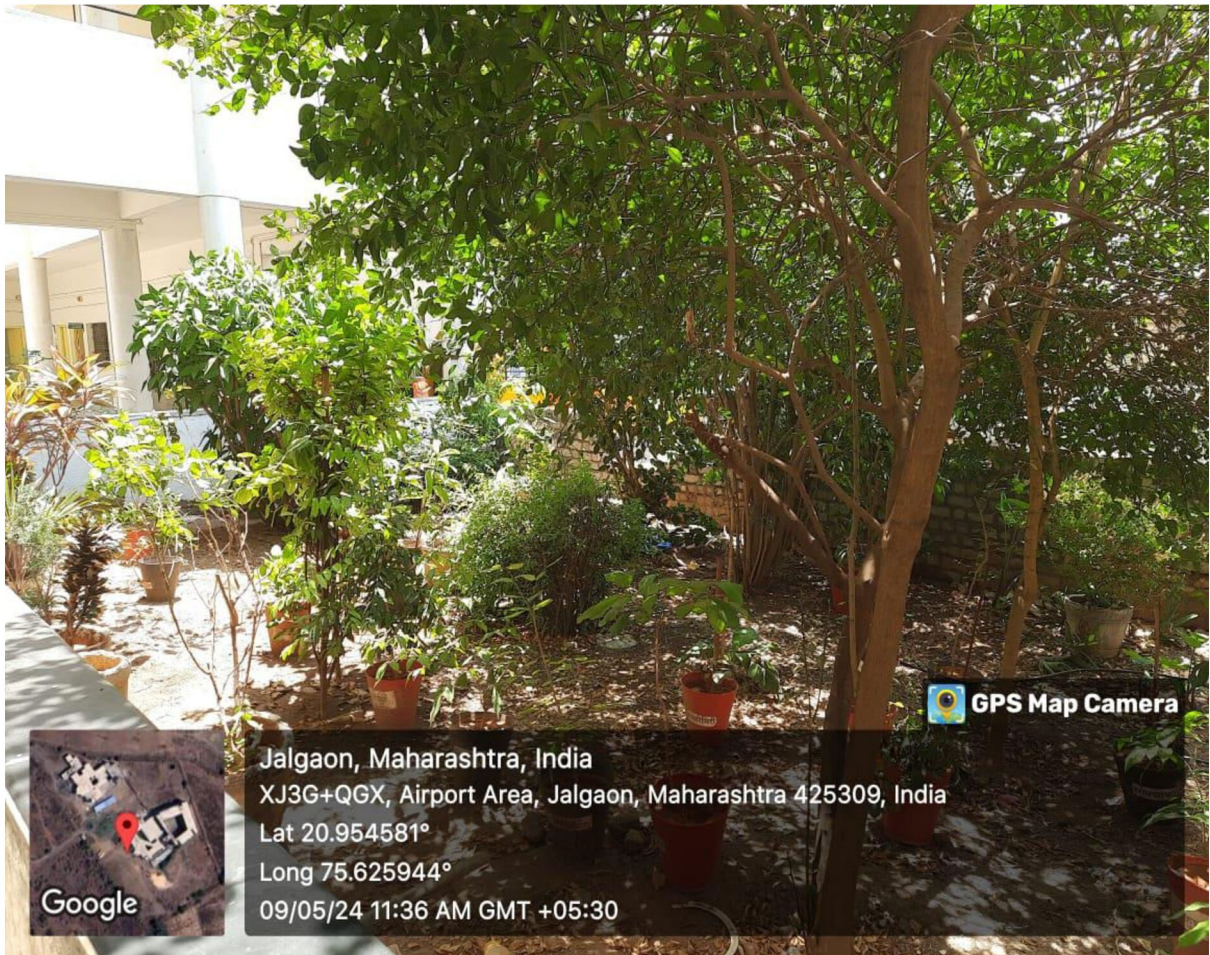
